Currently residing in California, Cliff Wagner was born and raised in Greenwood, Miss., where he absorbed the elements of traditional bluegrass, a key ingredient of his musical style. This latest CD derives its title from a poem written by a friend of Cliff's grandmother. Several of the selections, including the title song, were recorded at a live event in San Pedro, Cal. Ten of the fourteen tracks were penned by Cliff, including "The Loneliest Man," "The Ghetto By The Sea," and "We'll Get By." His performance on "Old Fire" clearly reflects his Mississippi blues roots. "My Native Land" is vintage Cliff Wagner and should appeal to anyone who appreciates bluegrass with a unique twist.
